**Please read all regulations carefully**

**All classes in the schedule are open to AMATEUR exhibitors only**

Eggs must not be washed but may be cleaned with a dry abrasive. One egg of each entry will be tested for freshness. To be judged on weight, freshness, texture of shell and shape.

**S20** Six Hen Eggs

**S21** Six Fresh Duck Eggs

**All fruit to have leaves displayed.**

**S22** Collection of Kitchen Herbs, Home Grown (Four varieties to be named)

**S23** Head of Lettuce with roots

**S24** Head of Cabbage

**S25** Head of Cauliflower

**S26** Head of Broccoli

**S27** Three Varieties of Root or Tuber Vegetable, eg Carrots, Radish

**S28** Three Spring Onions

**S29** Three Onions (red or white)

**S30** Six stalks of Silver Beet

**S31** Pumpkin (stem attached)

**S32** Six Pods of Peas

**S33** Six Pods of Broad Beans

**S34** Six of any One Variety of Berry, eg Strawberry, Mulberry

**S35** Three (3) Lemons, with leaves and stems attached

**S36** Collection of Citrus, Three (3) different varieties

**S37** Six Stalks of Rhubarb, leaves attached

**S38** Collection of Four (4) Vegetables, grown by an amateur and to be arranged in a single container
