Class 1: Steer or Heifer

HSCW 170 – 219 kg (Est live weight 310 – 400 Kg @ 55% dressed)

Fat range (P8) 4 - 12 mm fat, Rib fat 3 – 7 mm, milk teeth only.

Class 2: Steer or Heifer

HSCW 220 – 279 kg (Est live weight 401 – 500 Kg @ 55% dressed)

Fat range (P8) 6 – 14mm, Rib fat 4 – 8 mm milk teeth only.

Class 3: Steer Only

HSCW 280 – 330 kg (Est live weight 501 – 600 Kg @ 55% dressed)

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. Any beef breed or any cross breed steer or heifer.
2. Judges – The persons appointed to judge by the Committee.
3. Every exhibit must be the property of the exhibitor at judging day & must have been owned by him/her for at least 2 months immediately prior to judging day.
4. Entry Forms must be lodged with the Carcase Competition Secretary before the closing date & must be signed by the exhibitor or the exhibitor's agent.
5. Mouthing, all entries will be mouthed to comply with the classes of the schedule.
6. The judge, in making his decision in classes for livestock, will take into account early maturity, quality, conformation, development, evenness of depth of flesh, absence of any wasteful fat and most suitable for the trade.
7. The judge will not be bound to grant an award to any exhibit, which in his opinion he considers of insufficient merit or over age to receive such award.
8. An exhibit, after arrival at the saleyards, shall not be withdrawn from judging unless approved by the Committee.
9. Once cattle are penned, they cannot be moved unless authorized by the Chief Steward.
10. In the event of any question or dispute arising as to any matter or thing effecting the entry or retention of any animal, in the judging pens or effecting the exhibition or qualification of any animal, or as to the right or obligation of any exhibitor or the Society, every such question and dispute may be referred by the society or by the exhibitor or other part affected to the Chief Steward, who shall determine such question or dispute acting upon such information and evidence and his decision shall be final and accepted as binding upon all parties to such question or dispute and upon all person effected thereby.
11. All cattle will be weighed, numbered and penned into their respective classes prior to judging on Mon 19th Nov 11am
12. All entries must be accompanied by the proper fee or they will not be accepted.
13. Entries in individual classes cannot be entered in the pen of three.
14. There will be flexibility in the live judging for entries to be re-assigned to their correct kilogram weight class. Cattle outside of the competition H.S.C.W. class range may be penalized.
15. The Society will take every care in assisting exhibitors to yard and handle exhibits but accepts no responsibility for loss or injury.
16. All exhibitors or their respective representatives must be in attendance on arrival of the cattle at the yards and must all cattle must be identify with their correct tags.
17. All carcasses will be purchased by MC Herd P/L with price determined on quality & weight.
18. **HORNS:** All entries must be polled or dehorned. **No scur or bud must exceed 5cm (2").**
19. The entry fee is set by the society at \$60 per animal.
20. Any steer showing secondary sex characteristics will be deemed to be a bull and will not be eligible to an award.
21. All exhibitors are requested to sign the declaration on the entry form that no Hormonal Growth Promotants have been used in their exhibits. Failure to do so renders the exhibit ineligible for the competition.
22. **Exhibitors not curfewing animals the night before may be at a disadvantage.**
23. **Cattle must arrive at the yards between 7.00 and 9.00 am on Monday 18th Nov**
24. **All entries must have an NLIS ear tag in place.**
25. **Competition tags to go in ear opposite NLIS tag, please remove all other tags.**
26. **IMPORTANT: All exhibitors are required to supply and sign the National Vendor Declaration.**
27. **50 Maximum entries**
